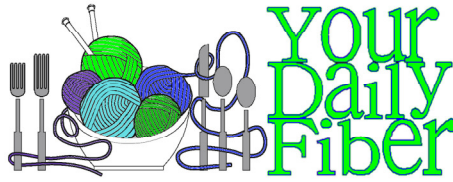

**“Learn to Spin”** (beginning spinners)

**Included:** drop spindle, fiber, and printed material.

Students will receive instruction on various Kromski spinning wheels. Kromski wheels are provided for use during classes. Students are allowed and encouraged to use the wheels for practice during the duration of the class in the store, during normal store hours.

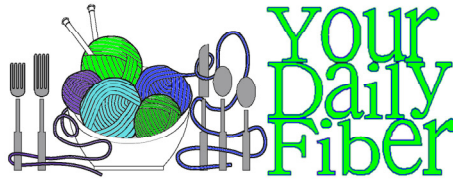

Thrummed mittens have been around for a couple of hundred years in Northern Newfoundland and Labrador. The term “thrums” refers to yarn waste from weaving looms. Learn to use double pointed needles, along with “roving” fiber, while making these toasty, colorful, very useful, one-of-a-kind mittens. Winter is not over!

BEGINNING KNITTING SKILLS REQUIRED. EXPERIENCE ON DOUBLE POINTED NEEDLES HELPFUL, BUT NOT REQUIRED.

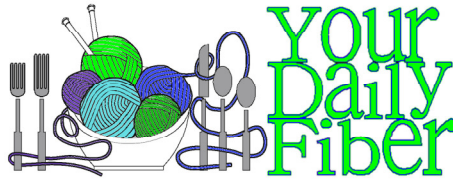
